

About Us

Glenn & Pamela Bateman opened Center Point Pond in 1996. The pond, originally dug in the early 1950's by the James Bateman family, was used as a water hole for livestock. It was quickly expanded with the Bateman children having memories of swimming, fishing, boating, and skating at the pond. In 1992, Glenn shared his vision of a fishing pond with Pamela on one of their first dates as he quickly caught a large mouth bass. Today, the pond is open to the public for fishing. Thousands of children, many with special needs, have experienced fishing for the first time. The pond also plays host to adults as well as senior groups from local retirement communities.

When Glenn is not teaching children fishing and pond ecology, he is advising about ponds & has installed water features into hundreds of backyards in the Delaware Valley.

Take PA Turnpike 76 West to Plymouth Meeting Exit Interstate 476 North. Continue on 476 until the Northeast extension to Lansdale Exit. At exit's light turn left and continue straight until Rt. 363. Make right onto 363. Continue on Route 363 to Center Point. Center Point Pond will be on your left approximately 500 yards past the 363/73 intersection.
